

LAKESIDE BARK RULES

1. The use of this “Run Facility” is by implied consent.
2. Caution “User Beware”.
3. This dog run is for healthy exercise and desirable social interaction in an unleashed environment. Discipline and obedience are encouraged.
4. Dog owners are legally responsible for their dogs and any injuries caused by them.
5. Dogs must be properly licensed, inoculated and healthy.
6. Female dogs in heat (ready for breeding) shall not be allowed in this run facility.
7. NO glass containers or smoking shall be allowed in this run facility.
8. This dog run is for dogs only – NO other animals or pets.
9. Dog abuse shall not be tolerated in this run facility.
10. Dogs showing rude or undesirable aggressive behavior are not welcome and shall be removed from the run.
11. Four (4) dogs total per section maximum capacity. One (1) hour time limit per visit if other patrons are waiting. Dogs shall be admitted on a first come first served basis.
12. Large Dog Section: Dogs 30-pounds or more
Small Dog Section: Dogs less than 30-pounds
13. Dog owners shall be in responsible charge of their dog and shall not leave their dog unattended or out of sight. Dogs left unattended shall be removed by Animal Control Authorities.
14. Dog owners must carry a leash at all times. Dogs shall be leashed before entering and prior to exiting the run. All dog feces shall be cleaned-up and properly disposed of by dog owners.
15. Children under 10-years old are not allowed in the run facility. Children 10 - 16 years must be supervised by an adult.
16. Dog run facility opens at 8:00 AM and closes at dusk.
17. Run Policing: Run Patrons are left to their own supervision. If Patrons cannot use this facility in a harmonious and respectful manner it shall be abandoned and dismantled.
18. Dog bites shall immediately be reported to the Chautauqua County Sheriff’s Department “911”
