Please separate items (metal/housewares/lumber). Please **no** out of Village Junk!
- **Household Hazardous Waste Drop off Date** is scheduled for **Saturday July 11, 2020 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.** at the Town of Chautauqua Highway Barn located at 50 Patterson St., Mayville. - **Brush, Limb & Grass Clipping Collection**
Brush & Limb - Curbside collection First & Third Monday
Grass Clippings - Curbside every Monday in buckets/barrels (**no plastic bags**)

October 19th thru November 27th (no plastic bags)
- **Winter Parking Regulations**
No parking on public streets from **November 1st thru March 31st from 1 am – 7 am**
- **Private Snow Plowing:** Do not plow snow into or across any street
