

Update: Village of Mayville Drinking Water

“Do Not Drink” Advisory is Discontinued effective December 24th, 2020

MAYVILLE, N.Y. The Do Not Drink Advisory for the Village of Mayville’s Public Water Supply is discontinued effective December 24th, 2020. Your water is now acceptable for drinking, food preparation and all household uses.

Coordination between the Village of Mayville, Chautauqua County and the New York State Departments of Environmental Conservation and Health has ensured that a new water source for the Village, Well #4, is now online and providing clean water to Village residents. Water testing has confirmed Well #4 has no detectable levels of PFNA.

Sampling results show levels of P--FNA continue to go down in the Village water storage tank. Efforts are underway by the Village to flush the tank of old water and replace it with clean water from Well #4. Additional engineering measures are being taken to maximize use of Well #4 to meet the needs of the Village and continue to lower levels in the storage tank. As a result, the “do not drink” advisory will be lifted effective December 24th, 2020. The water system will continue to be monitored on a biweekly basis and results will be made available to the public.
