
Mayville Earth Day Clean-up

After you've finished cleaning up, return to any of these locations to submit your entry for exciting door prizes. Let's work together to keep Mayville beautiful!



New Rules for Yard Waste Brush, Limb & Grass Clipping Collection




- Limbs and branches are collected on the first and third Monday of each
- Limbs/branches should be no longer than 10' and 6" in diameter, cut from trees or shrubs. No whole trees
- Please place all limbs and branches neatly stacked parallel with the street, with the butt end facing the direction of traffic.

- Your containers must placed by the street on Sunday evening or befo 7:30 am on Monday.
- Please be aware that any yard waste not in containers will not be collected.

Open Burning: Part 1

Burning ban in effect from March 16 through May 14 via NY DEC management policy

Allowed:

- 1. Recreational Fires: Enjoy a cozy fire up to 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet in height for various purposes like relaxation, cooking, or warmth.
- Bonfires: Experience larger fires for ceremonies (permit may be required).
- 3. Portable Outdoor Fireplaces: Safely contain solid fuel with a non-combustible design, featuring a door opening and chimney for outdoor enjoyment.

Not Allowed:

- 1. Burning for Disposal: This includes a wide range of items such as trash, garbage, refuse, waste, carcasses, leaves, clothing/textiles, chemicals, plastics, oils, tires, and petroleum products.
- 2. During windy conditions more than 5 mph
