

STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION

Village of Mayville, New York

December 10, 2020

Pursuant to the authority granted to me pursuant to Article 2-B, Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, the Village of Mayville hereby declares a local state of emergency effective Monday, January 11, 2021.

This local state of emergency has been declared due to an emergency with the Village of Mayville water system and water supply.

In a coordinated effort with Chautauqua County and representatives of New York State, this proactive declaration is made to protect the general public and to ensure the delivery of a safe water supply to the community.

While the Village of Mayville is able to provide safe drinking water through its municipal supply at this time, the Village of Mayville is still unable to use three (3) wells and still diagnosing problems with its water supply. If the last operating well should no longer be usable, the Village of Mayville will distribute potable drinking water through the duration of this state of emergency.

Our employees will be available to assist the public during normal hours of operation by telephone at (716) 753-2013 04 (716) 269-4801. We can provide emergency assistance after regularly scheduled business hours at (716) 269-4801.

This State of Emergency will remain in effect for a period not to exceed 30 days or until rescinded, whichever occurs first. This order may be extended for an additional period not to exceed 30 days.

As the Mayor of the Village of Mayville, I Kenneth Shearer, Jr. exercise the authority given to me under Article 2-B, Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, for the purpose of procuring goods and services, and to render all required and available assistance that is vital to the security, well-being, and health and safety of the citizens of the Village of Mayville.
